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**Positive Behavior in Schools III: Bullying Prevention**

**Course Description:**  
Bullying Prevention is the third course provided by the Kentucky Department of Education and produced by Kentucky Educational Television that satisfies the training requirement of 704 KAR 7:160 Use of Restraint and Seclusion in Public Schools. The focus of this year's training, which includes two modules, is on effective bullying prevention strategies in the context of schoolwide positive behavioral interventions and support systems. The two modules will include information about:

- The negative effects of bullying and the prevalence of bullying in Kentucky and nationally
- Different types of bullying
- Components of effective bullying prevention strategies
- Effective bullying prevention strategies (using dramatic scenarios)

Note: This is a self-paced course accessible for one year after enrollment, and not eligible for graduate credit.
